Programme at a Glance

Format	One month, part-time — approx. 10 hours per week over 4 weeks (~40 hours total, about five working days of effort).
Team size	Teams of 2–4 working professionals from any background; no coding background required.
Intakes	Monthly — a new cohort every month.
Mentorship	Expert mentorship from AI Engineers at AI Singapore (AISG).
Tools provided	AI coding assistants and an LLM API key provided for the duration of the programme.
Certification	Digital certificate of completion.
